The One Health Network of India (OHNI), led by IIPHG and COHERD, promotes an interdisciplinary approach linking human, animal, and environmental health. It addresses zoonotic diseases, antimicrobial resistance (AMR), biosecurity, surveillance, health systems, and WASH to counter emerging threats. With rising zoonotic outbreaks, climate-related health risks, and AMR, India needs a skilled One Health workforce. However, One Health is still underrepresented in education and institutions. The One Health Training Programme bridges this gap, offering practical knowledge and collaboration skills to prepare students as future One Health champions, ready to tackle complex health challenges through integrated, cross-sectoral action.
